

## **Fertility Service referrals: information required**

Referrals to the fertility service will be dealt with more quickly if they contain the following information:

1. Names and dates of birth of both partners
2. Semen analysis result, with a repeat result if the first is abnormal
3. Copies of health screening test results for the female partner including: rubella, blood group and antibodies, FBC, Hep B Ag, HIV and treponema
4. Plasma progesterone on day 21-23 if normal cycle. If woman's cycle is longer than 42 days, then LH, FSH, estradiol, TSH and prolactin on day 2-5 of the cycle is required.
5. BMI of woman
6. If BMI is outside 18-32 then please include evidence of a supervised weight improving programme with the referral letter.
7. If BMI is outside the range 16-35 a referral will not be admitted until within this range.
8. If the infertile woman is a current smoker access to publicly funded treatments will not be possible.
