- Population health challenges
  - Small rural communities with ageing and often reducing populations
  - Distances to travel for care and limited transport
  - Priority areas identified in the Southern Health Profile
- Financial challenges
  - Ageing and slow growing population – sustainability question looming
  - Old buildings
  - High cost of delivery particularly for community/rural services
